FACT SHEET

The Housing Authority of the City of Muskogee (MHA), established in 1969, provides affordable housing and housing assistance programs for low-income families in the Muskogee area. In addition to managing 582 units of housing MHA also has the capacity to assist 873 families with rental assistance via the Housing Choice Voucher program (when full funding is appropriated by Congress). Programs operated by the Housing Authority include supportive housing for elderly and disabled families, market-based rental, Neighborhood Stabilization Program rental, HOME program rental units, and Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing vouchers. MHA also manages the operations of several non-profit agencies as well as the Stilwell Housing Authority's 80 Public Housing and 29 Housing Choice Voucher units.
